Currans Well EM survey to commence

Bannon (ASX:BNX) advises that historic reconnaissance (RC) drilling at the Currans Well Project has intercepted nickel and copper mineralisation where electromagnetic (EM) conductors have been defined. As a result of this Bannon is undertaking a MLEM survey over the balance of the property.




Figure 1: Existing conductors and area of planned EM survey on magnetic image of the Currans Well tenements.

Experienced geophysical consultants and nickel and copper exploration specialists have modeled a number of EM conductors at the Currans Well Project (*see Figure 1*). EM is the standard technique used in exploration for significant nickel and copper sulphides.

In addition, the Company is currently reviewing historical data to define priority drill targets. The interpreted geology combined with a number of identified targets (*Figure 1*) highlight the prospectivity of Currans Well and suggests the opportunity to locate additional mineralisation.

The Currans Well project is located in the Central Yilgarn Craton of Western Australia and comprises seven prospecting licenses covering portions of the Youanmi Intrusive Complex. Historic and recent exploration has located a number of Ni-Cu(AuPGM) enriched sulphide horizons spatially associated with contacts between different phases of the mafic-ultramafic intrusive. Ultramafic -mafic rocks are preferential host rocks for nickel sulphide deposits.

Following completion of the MLEM survey and interpretation of the results the Company will prioritise drill targets and the implementation of a drill program.
